



Continuing Education & Professional Development

Please note that clinical trainings do not apply.

All NYCB certificants – Certified Addiction Recovery Coach (CARC), Certified Recovery Peer Advocate (CRPA), CRPA-Family and CRPA-Youth – are required to engage in ongoing recovery-focused training (in-person and online) throughout the period of certification. The purpose of continuing education is to develop personal skills, ensure continuing best practice, confirm trends in the field and in preparation for timely renewal before professional certification expires.

Programs and training certificates carrying the NYCB Training Approval logo are preferred.
