Certified Addiction Recovery Coach (CARC)	15 hours recovery-specific education	plus	3 hours Peer Ethics
Certified Recovery Peer Advocate (CRPA)	24 hours recovery-specific education	plus	4 hours Peer Ethics

Build your **Recovery-Specific** continuing education on the following non-clinical, SUD-focused skills and topics:

- **Communication Skills** such as purposeful conversation; motivational interviewing; strategic story sharing;
- **Resource Building** including local and community; public/private; state and nationwide
- **Hot-button topics** that bring challenges into the conversation - for example, spirituality in recovery; cultural humility and competence; managing conflict and professional detachment; etc.
- **Trends in the peer recovery profession** including one-time documented attendance at Bronx Council on Alcohol and Substance Use Disorders; CCAR webinar; FOR-NY Community Based Recovery Supports (CBRS); OASAS Alumni Association; OASAS-Recovery Implementation Team (RIT)
