







## Professional Peer Certification? Follow these Steps

Limited number of scholarships available to cover training cost, certification application fees, and exam fee:

Certified Recovery Peer Advocate (CRPA) only

Minimum of 46 hours NYCB-approved training – choice of, CCAR Recovery Coach Academy (30 hours) plus Peer Ethics (16 hours), or a single custom-designed training program.
