Minimum continuing education required for renewal:

Certified Addiction Recovery Coach (CARC) 15 hours recovery-specific education *plus* 3 hours Peer Ethics

Certified Recovery Peer Advocate (CRPA) 24 hours recovery-specific education *plus* 4 hours Peer Ethics

Build your Recovery-Specific continuing education on the following non-clinical, SUD-focused skills and topics:

- > Communication Skills such as purposeful conversation; motivational interviewing; strategic story sharing;
- > Resource Building including local and community; public/private; state and nationwide
- **Hot-button topics** that bring challenges into the conversation for example, spirituality in recovery; cultural humility and competence; managing conflict and professional detachment; etc.
- > Trends in the peer recovery profession including one-time documented attendance at Bronx Council on Alcohol and Substance Use Disorders; CCAR webinar; FOR-NY Community Based Recovery Supports (CBRS); OASAS Alumni Association; OASAS-Recovery Implementation Team (RIT)
