

The Expiration Term of Service (ETS) Sponsorship Program

Bridging the gap from active duty to civilian life

What problem does ETS address?

- The troubling and increasing suicide rates of Servicemembers as they transition into civilian life
- The period of significant risk for these young(18–34-year-old) Veterans is in their first year after separating from the military
- Studies indicate that 44% to 72% experience high levels of stress during transition from military to civilian life



What is the goal of ETS?

- The ETS Sponsorship Program assists service members in transition to civilian life and the post-military community of their choice.
- Engaging transitioning Servicemembers prior to them exiting the military (typically 6 months out)
- Connecting them to certified sponsors in their postmilitary hometowns and community organizations to assist with their transition
- Enrolling them in needed VA and community services



What areas does a sponsor assist with?

- Employment
- Education
- Housing
- Legal concerns
- Service benefits
- Medical and mental health care issues




ETS in New York State
