

ASAP-NYCB Certification Standards Criminal Justice Supported Recovery (CJSR) November 2023

- a. **Pre-requisite**: Recognized foundational peer certification in good standing: CARC, CRPA, Certified Peer Specialist (MH), Certified Peer Workers (HIV, Harm Reduction, Hep C), Family Peer Advocate (FTNYS), Youth Peer Advocate (FTNYS) or other recognized peer certification from reputable credentialing bodies nationwide;
- b. **Education**: High School Diploma or GED or IEP, or equivalent or higher (matriculated);
- c **Role Experience**: Six months experience providing, directly or as part of a team, peer-related services to justice-involved individuals;
- d. **Training**: Completion of a 20-hour ASAP-NYCB approved training program;
- e **Ethics**: Attestation to the CJSR Ethical Framework adopted by ASAP-NYCB, November 2023.
